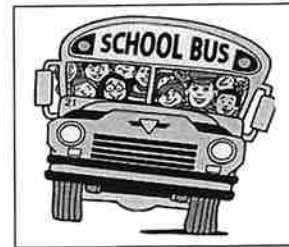

TRANSPORTATION

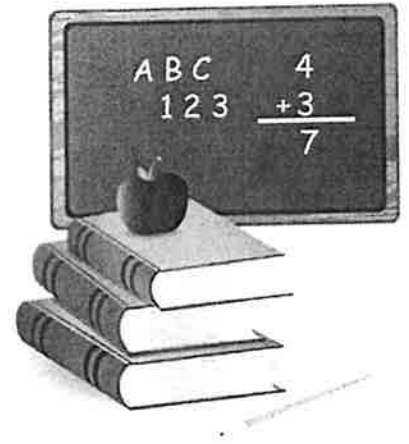
If you have any questions or changes regarding busing for your child, **PLEASE** call the Transportation Department at least 1 week prior to school starting.

Fourth Grade Supply List

Welcome to Fourth Grade! We are looking forward to a great year at Reilly Elementary School.

This is a list of supplies that will be needed.

- 5 folders with pockets (please purchase 1 of each color: red, blue, purple, green, yellow)
- 5 spiral notebooks (please purchase 1 of each color: red, blue, purple, green, yellow)
- Pencils and erasers
- 6 or more glue sticks
- Container to hold crayons, pencils, etc.
(Consider an old lunch box or zippered bag. They work best.)
- Headphones or earbuds
- Scissors
- 24 count crayons and 12 colored pencils (no pens or markers)
- 6 or more black dry erase markers (skinny are preferred)
