Procedures for inviting the Part C service coordinator to initial Individualized Education Program (IEP) meeting upon parent request

 Director of Special Services, District School Psychologist or Preschool Supervisor invite Part C service coordinator to initial IEP meeting at parent request

Procedures for considering extended school year services

 Extended school year services are considered at every IEP meeting based on individual student needs.

Procedures for any noncompliance finding

- Director of Special Services will review any noncompliance findings.
- Director of Special Services will collaborate with EMIS and other related preschool personnel to correct any findings.

Data reporting of Part C to Part B transitions

- Director of Special Services enters event dates directly into the Student Information System (SIS) for Transition Conference, Referral, Consent, Initial Evaluation Team Meeting, Initial Individualized Education Plan Meeting
- Director of Special Services notifies EMIS of preschool start date and disability condition to ensure match with events reported
- Director of Special Services reviews any errors made available through Crosscheck and EMIS reports provided by EMIS coordinator
- Prior to data submission closing, Director of Special Services uses Part C to Part B checklist to ensure all transitioning students are reporting accurately
