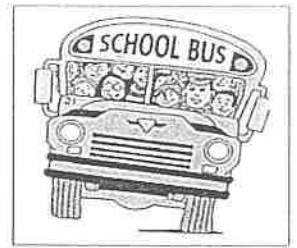

## REVISED STUDENT DRESS CODE

The Salem Board of Education recently revised the student dress code for all Salem students.

The complete dress code is found in the student handbook found on our district website.

### STUDENTS ARE NOT PERMITTED TO WEAR:

- \*Shoes without socks
- \*Shoes that are safety hazards (flip flops, high heels, shoes with wheels, etc.)
- \*Clothes with pictures or words inappropriate for school
- \*Hats/hoods/bandanas in school
- \*Clothes that expose excessive skin (ripped jeans, short shorts, muscle shirts, midriff shirts)
- \*Tank tops less than three fingers width wide
- \*Pajama pants or sleepwear
- \*Facial piercings
- \*Unnatural hair coloring



## Dismissal Options

We want our students to get home safely every day. Our Reilly families have 3 dismissal option from which to choose:

### **Option # 1 – WALKERS**

**\*Dismissed at 3:00**

\*Students will walk out of the building and down our sidewalks to go home. Crossing guards are on duty for major intersections.

\*Parents parking on Ohio Ave. and Oak St. can also have their child walk out to them at this time. (Parents CANNOT park in our parking lot for this option.)

### **Option # 2 – CAR RIDERS**

**\*Dismissed at 3:05**

\*Parents park in 5 organized lanes in the South side of our parking lot.

\*Students will be escorted out to the car line. All cars remain still until every student gets in a car.

\*Lines are dismissed one at a time to depart our lot.

### **Option # 3 – BUS RIDERS**

**\*Dismissed to the gym at 3:15**

\*Students sit in organized bus lines.

\*As buses arrive, students walk out in an organized fashion to board their bus.

\*Students ride their bus to their bus stop, home, or daycare.
